This is a play about fuzziness, about our attempts to make life less fuzzy, and what happens when we think we've got life, love and God sussed. It's also a play about the relative merits of chess and Ker-plunk," said Rev Dean. Tickets are £5 on the door and refreshments will be available. The play is not recommended for those under the age of 15.
