Elder Nominations

We are seeking to strengthen and build the Eldership/Trustees team. Therefore, we are inviting members to prayerfully discern what the Lord is saying. Please use some of the scripture references (1 Tim 3:8-13; Titus 1:6-9; Acts 6:1-6; 1Thess 2:11-12) in helping us identify the Spirit filled women and men with the characteristics and giftings to enhance the team and bless our community.

Our constitution states that Elders are appointed by anonymous vote at a Church meeting which will be on Monday, 3 June 2024, to serve for a period of 3 years, after which they can re-stand for a further 3 years if they so wish. After 2 terms they must stand down for at least a year to ensure they are replenished and to give opportunities for others to serve the Fellowship. We are grateful to Richard South who has served us faithfully for two terms and will be stepping down from this role in June.

We are not looking for super-heroes, just men and women committed to seeking after God's vision and call upon the body of Christ at Witard Road. If you wish to discuss the role and responsibilities further, please do not hesitate to speak to Pastor Steve or any of the elders. Members of WRBC are requested to nominate another member for these positions, after you have spoken to the nominee and they are willing to stand, please will you write or email Mandy Budden by no later than Sunday, 12 May. All nominees will require a minimum of three supporting members prior to meeting with Pastor Steve and an elder to discuss the roles and responsibilities further.

In line with the Constitution the names of nominees must be announced to the members two Sundays before the next Church meeting, therefore, any announcement would be Sunday, 26 May, prior to the church meeting on Monday 3 June.
